Activities

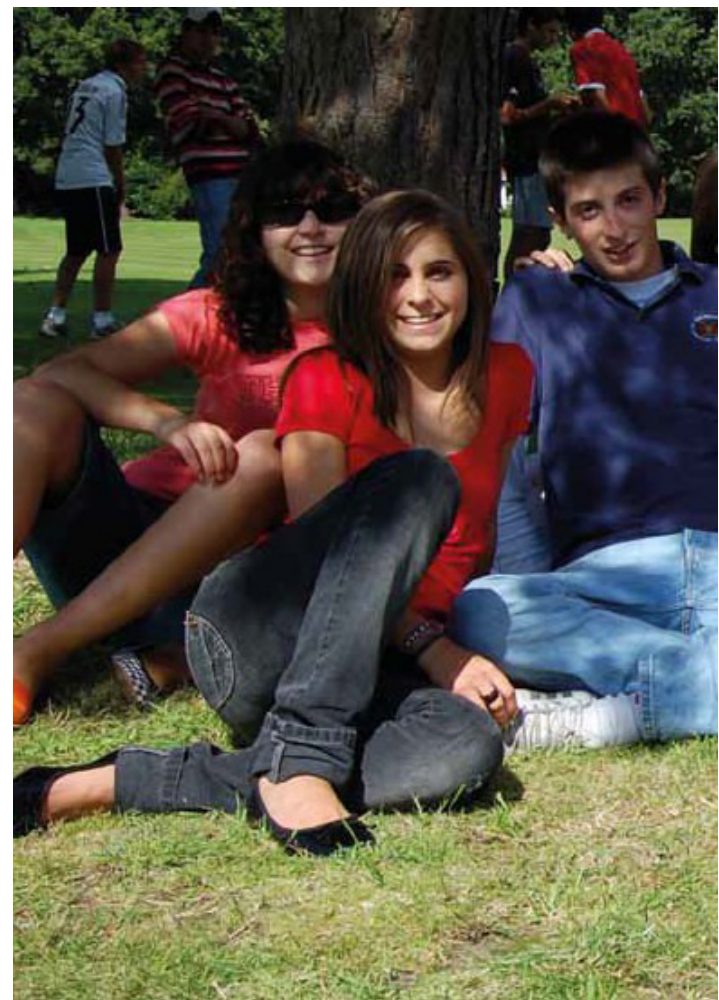

Welfare

Our students' welfare is our highest priority. All students are supervised 24 hours a day.

Separate accommodation for boys and girls is provided. We have dormitories or larger rooms for the younger students while the older students have single, double or triple rooms. Three hot meals a day are provided except when the students are out on an excursion, and then packed lunches are provided.

There is always a choice of hot and cold food as well as a vegetarian option and a fresh salad bar. Students staying for three weeks will have their clothes laundered once during their stay. A Welfare Officer is available 24 hours and takes care of all students personal and medical needs. There is a safe deposit and banking service and all students have access to a safe for personal items.
